2. It is further **ORDERED** that any material sealed pursuant to this Order shall be conditionally disclosed upon the entry of a further order by this Court finding that such

opening is necessary for purposes of judicial or governmental accountability or First Amendment rights.

3. It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby directed to post a copy of the attached Notice of Entry of Order Authorizing Sealing and/or Redaction on the Clerk's and Court's websites for a period of fifteen (15) days and to affix a copy of the Order on the outside of the court record.
4. It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby authorized to unseal any materials sealed pursuant to this Order for the purpose of filing, microfilming or imaging files, or transmitting a record to an appellate tribunal. The materials shall be resealed immediately upon completion of the filing.
